Searchlight

- The searchlight should be installed on flat, level, and non-metal surface.
- Make use of the foam gasket to mark mounting and wiring access (1 in /25.4 mm) on flat surface, see picture. Make wiring access.
- 3 Route the power cable and signal lines through wiring access of the gasket and flat surface.
- Secure deck mount by four (4) self-tapping screws of 1/4 in (6 mm), or bolts and nuts.
- Remember to install the foam gasket, and ensure proper sealing.

Remote Control Bracket

- Take off mounting plate from the back of bracket. Secure mounting plate on selected location with the two (2) self-tapping screws (included).
- 2 Fit bracket to mounting plate as shown.
- Provide water and weather protection for the location where remote control is installed.

Searchlight not responding to remote control

Installation work and repairs to electrical components of this product must only be carried out by a suitably qualified and competent person in accordance with current local and national safety regulations. Repairs and other work by unqualified persons could be dangerous.

- Press and hold button for 2 seconds.
- 2 Move to a location that is less than 15 meters away.

The manufacturer cannot be held liable for unauthorized work.

- Move to a location that has no obstructing structure between remote control and searchlight.
- Replace battery for remote control.

Light not turning on

- Secure light bulb.
- 2 Replace light bulb if necessary.
- 3 Check if the wireless remote's battery is in good condition.
- 4 Check if the fixed mount wireless remote's power connection is in good condition.
- 5 Check if the wire harness is in good condition.

TROUBLESHOOTING





Spot mode or flood mode not functioning

• Secure and replace light bulb.

Searchlight not responding well to any control

- Check voltage of inboard battery.
- 2 Carefully uninstall the searchlight. Examine all the electrical connections.
- 3 Check if the wireless remote's battery is in good condition.
- 4 Check if the fixed mount wireless remote's power connection is in good condition.
- **5** Check if the wire harness is in good connection.
- 6 Check the fuse or circuit breaker that protects searchlight and fixed mount control.
 - DO NOT replace a blown fuse until the cause of searchlight malfunction is identified and resolved.
 - DO NOT replace a blown fuse with a fuse that takes higher current.

Brightness of the light is significantly decayed

- Replace light bulb.
- For other problems, and when problem is not solved with the above tips
- Return complete product with proper packaging to dealer for inspection.
- Include a description of the problem, user contact information, and proof of purchase if requesting warranty service.



Optional Fixed Mount Wireless Remote Control

- Provide 12V DC input power for optional fixed wireless control
- Easy connection with its two wires, black (-) and red (+), connected to the battery box. There is no wiring to the searchlight itself.
- 3 Fixed mount remote control.

This optional fixed mount remote control works wireless with the searchlight. It does not operate by batteries, it simply requires to be connect to a 12V DC power source. No additional connection is needed.



Wireless Remote Control

1 Press arrow key to control rotation of the searchlight.

Wireless Remote Control Battery Operated Spot/Flood Switch

2 Change light beam coverage by spot/flood switch.

3 Same operation for fixed mount remote control.

Optional Fixed Wireless Remote Control Spot/Flood Switch

Caution

- ! Continuous operation for more than two (2) hours should be avoided. Longer continuous operation time may consume the light bulb quickly.
- ! DO NOT try to operate the product beyond angular range as it will damage the product.
- ! DO NOT press or hit the glass front cover.
- ! DO NOT look directly into the searchlight while the product is in operation.
- DO NOT cover the light with any material, otherwise accidental activation of the product may result in fires.

How to replace battery

- Remove remote control from bracket.
- 2 Loosen the two (2) screws from back cover
- 3 Carefully dissemble remote control
- 4 Replace the used 12V / A23 battery with new one.
- 5 Push any button to check if the LED indicator illuminates.
- To conduct general care:
 Use diluted neutral cleanser for general cleaning.
 No need to provide additional lubrication.
 Do not use other chemicals or abrasives.

Searchlight with Wireless Remote Contol

- 1 Provide 12V DC input power for LED wireless searchlight.
- 2 Protect input power positive (+) terminal with 10 Amp fuse or circuit.
- Use 12-gauge power cable for wiring distance not more than 30 ft. (9 m), and use 10-gauge power cable for longer wiring distance.
